

Simple 90-Day Community Group Hosting Guide
Heaven, How I Got Here
A simple timeline for your community group

1. Plan with Prayer — 3 Months Before

- Pray for the gathering.
- Choose a date and location.
- Decide who will host.
- Begin praying for one or two friends to invite.

2. Invite Personally — 2 Months Before

- Invite friends, neighbors, coworkers, or family personally.
- Encourage every group member to invite their friends,
- Share the event details through text messages or social media if appropriate.
- Continue praying for those you plan to invite.

3. Prepare Together — 1 Month Before

- Confirm the host, refreshments, and seating.
- Decide who will welcome guests and facilitate discussion.
- Test the video and audio equipment.
- Continue inviting guests and praying for them by name.

4. Final Preparation — 1 Week Before

- Send reminders to volunteers and guests.
- Purchase or prepare refreshments (optional).
- Set up the viewing space.
- Pray together for the evening and for each guest.

5. Event Day

- Welcome guests warmly.
- Watch the film together.
- Share a short Gospel message or testimony.
- Encourage discussion, questions, and prayer.

6. Follow Up — Within One Week

- Thank guests for coming.
- Invite them to your next community group gathering or church service.
- Continue building relationships.
- Keep praying for each guest.
